Our successful Design Awards competition of recent years has grown. This year we are also inviting nominations for landscape and other projects, in addition to new and refurbished buildings – hence the change of title.

# CPRE Northamptonshire Town & Country Awards 2009

CPRE campaigns for a sustainable future for the English countryside, a vital but undervalued environmental, economic and social asset to the nation. We want our Awards to recognise projects in Northamptonshire that:

- protect the countryside
- assist urban renewal
- improve everyone's quality of life

## Which projects can be nominated?

These are the categories for this year's competition. We may not make an award in each category, and some categories may have more than one award. Projects in categories 1 – 4 must have been completed since 2004.

1. Preservation and enhancement of the landscape
2. A smaller-scale project involving the design and implementation of one of the following, which is publicly accessible, or in school grounds:
  - a garden
  - a wildlife area
  - a play area
  - an example of local craftsmanship
  - a newly-opened access to the countryside
3. Urban enhancements:
  - a public space in an urban area
  - regeneration in an urban area
  - re-use of a brownfield site
4. Buildings in any location featuring:
  - sympathetic restoration and re-use
  - an example of innovative new build
  - novel energy-saving measures
  - an outstanding design
5. A recent project over five years old, from any of the above categories, that is well-maintained and continues to meet its purpose

## What is awarded?

Each winner will receive a prestigious CPRE brass plaque and certificate.

## Key dates

Nominations should be submitted by **30<sup>th</sup> September 2009**. Entries will be assessed during October and the winners will be announced in November. A ceremony for the presentations is scheduled for 7.30 pm on Thursday, December 17<sup>th</sup> 2009 at Cranford Hall near Kettering.

## How do I make a nomination?

Anyone may submit a nomination. Please complete and send this form by post or fax, together with additional documentation as necessary. Alternatively, nominations by email are most welcome. Addresses are on the bottom right of this form.

## Who will judge the Awards?

The assessors' panel will be selected from the landscape and heritage building professionals in the county, and officers of CPRE.
